

FOREST IN AUSTRIA



- 48 % of the national territory is forest, about 4 million ha
- Timber stock is constantly increasing and currently amounts to 1.18 billion m³
- Only 89 % of the timber stock increase is harvested
- 81 % private forests → 137,000 owners (farm and family forests)
 - Private forests < 200 ha: 49 % (Small-scale forest owners)</p>
 - Private forests > 200 ha: 22 % (Large-scale forest owners)
 - ► Joint forests: 10 % (e.g. agricultural community)
- 19 % public forests → Austrian Federal Forests (15 %), Federal states (1 %)
 & Municipalities (3 %)

WHAT IS PEFC?



- PEFC = Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification schemes
- Leading global institution for promoting and ensuring sustainable forest management:
 - ✓ economical
 - √ ecological
 - √ social
- **Primary goal:** to preserve forests with their important functions for humans for future generations
- Implemented worldwide, adapted to the conditions in the respective country

ORIGIN OF PEFC




- 90s: Concern about tropical rainforests the "lungs of the world" was great
- 1/3 already destroyed: Timber used and forests converted to pasture without planting new trees
- The idea of forest management certification according to sustainability criteria for the protection of forests germinated
- PEFC founded in 1999, then called "Pan European Forest Certification"
- Certification of sustainable management should improve the fate of forests




- Founded in June 1999

- Latest revised system endorsed: 12.02.2025

- > 650 companies PEFC COC certified





PEFC REGIONS IN AUSTRIA





PEFC CERTIFICATION SUSTAINABLE FOREST MANAGEMENT



- ✓ Declaration of participation by the forest owner
- ✓ Internal audits (about 250/year) by employees of the chambers of agriculture
- ✓ Preparation of reports (regions & group level)
- ✓ External audits (40/year) by certification body (SGS Hamburg)
- ✓ Audit report by CB
- ✓ In case of deviations, improvement measures have to be taken
- ✓ Positive result: issue or continuation of the regions certificate
- ✓ One group certificate for all 8 regions in Austria
- √ The whole process is repeated annually

PEFC CERTIFICATION CHAIN OF CUSTODY



- ✓ Decision on **PEFC CoC** certification
- ✓ Obtain quotes from certification bodies
- ✓ Creation of PEFC structures in the company
- ✓ Initial audit
- ✓ Issue of the PEFC CoC certificate for 5 years
- ✓ Annual surveillance audits
- ✓ After 5 years **re-certification** audit

PEFC-LABEL



- Indicates that wood and wood products originate from sustainably managed forests
- Is independent, reliable and secure
- Enables customers to support sustainable forest management
- Shopping: choosing PEFC-certified products or packaging







WHAT IS PEFC PROJECT CERTIFICATION?



- Use of **PEFC-certified timber** in the construction project
- Certificate confirms the sustainable origin of the timber used for the building
- Verified by independent & state-accredited certification bodies:
